Please note, the date for Glencoe PS's **Term Two** School Development Day (previously advertised in the EC Parent Handbook) has been changed.

Students return for Term Two on Monday, 28 April. The student-free day for Term Two will now occur on Tuesday, 3 June 2025, meaning that students will have an additional day off school on the back of the WA Day Public Holiday. Reminders will be sent at the end of Term One, and also during Term Two, in the lead-up to this date.

Student Attendance

Attendance at school is vitally important. At Glencoe, we value every opportunity to help students learn and grow.

If you child is absent from school, please add an attendance note in Compass, respond to the SMS that is automatically-generated, or phone the front office to advise of the reason for the absence. Where absences remain unexplained at the end of the week, a Compass letter will be sent, outlining dates of absence and requesting an explanation. This is one of our measures to prioritise the follow-up of student attendance, this year.

If you are having difficulty getting your child to school for any reason, please don't hesitate to contact your child's teacher. By working together, our school community can support your child's attendance.

Before School Expectations

A reminder that all students on school grounds prior to 8:30am, should head directly to the canteen undercovered area, where supervision is provided. Students do not need to drop their bags to their classes; rather, they can head straight over, and keep their bags with them. This routine was introduced to ensure a smooth, calm and orderly start to the school day.

Parents are welcomed and encouraged to come across to the under-covered area with students. If you choose to wait outside the classroom, you need only be responsible for your own children. Other children will be directed by a member of staff, to the under-covered area.

Compass Update

From Tuesday, 25 February, parents and carers will be able to sign into the Compass app using a One-Time Passcode (OTP). This means that rather than entering your username and password, you will be able to click "Parent sign in with one-time code" (see below). Clicking this button will prompt you to enter your mobile number or email address. Compass will then send you a OTP, which can be entered, for sign-in. To use this feature, please ensure your details are up-to-date with the front office.
