#### Term Two Parent-Teacher Interviews

As communicated in last fortnight's newsletter, an **early close for Parent-Teacher Interviews** will be conducted each semester this year. The first opportunity for formal interviews with class teachers will occur in Week Three of Term Two, on **Monday 12 May**. On this date, the school day will finish for all students at 11:45am.

Meeting with teachers mid-way through the semester will provide somewhat of an interim verbal report, enabling the teacher and parents to speak about how their child has settled, and their areas of strength and challenge. It will also give an indication of expected achievement when formal Reports are written; ensuring shared understanding in advance of Semester Reporting.



#### Student Attendance

Attendance at school is vitally important. At Glencoe, we value every opportunity to help students learn and grow.

If your child is absent from school, please add an attendance note in Compass, respond to the SMS that is automatically-generated, or phone the front office to advise of the reason for the absence. Where absences remain unexplained at the end of the week, a Compass letter will be sent, outlining dates of absence and requesting an explanation. This is one of our measures to prioritise the follow-up of student attendance, this year.

#### Compass Update

From next **Wednesday**, **26 March**, Compass messaging will replace the school's current text messaging service. Messages sent and received will have a similar format as the school's current text messages, but they will appear to come from a new number, with a link to view the message.

As a security measure, this number may be different each time a message is received, but you will know it is from the school as messages will be titled "Glencoe PS".

#### Facebook Update

Glencoe PS now has an active, public Facebook page. We encourage parents and family members to 'like' and 'follow'. Over the coming weeks, you will start to see photographs from school events, reminders, P&C news etc. shared on the school's Facebook page.
